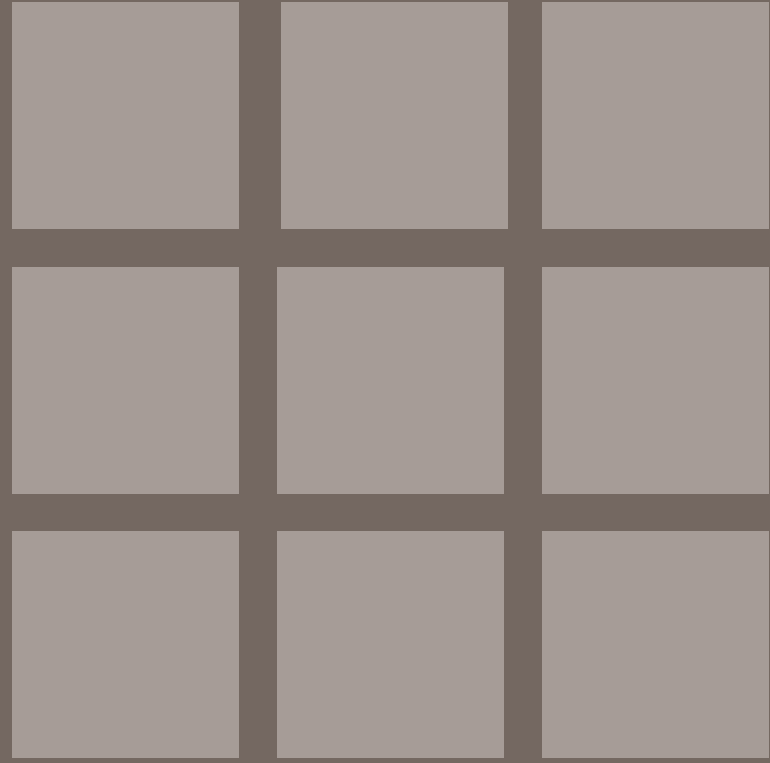

The First World War Museum Network is comprised of 19 bodies, small and large. These, which are spread throughout the province, are testimony to the interest that the First World War continues to generate.

Behind the museums there are opening sites pertinent to the war: mountains marked by trenches and permanent fortifications. Artefacts of that terrible war, when tens of thousands of men lived in extreme conditions, have been gathered from these sites, saved and displayed in museums by the passion of dedicated volunteers.

Although not always exclusively, these museums are dedicated to the memory of that conflict and are part of the wider "Trentino First World War Network".

Discover their specific themes and their link with the territory in which they reside. Have this leaflet stamped in one of the Network museums: visiting others can grant you discounted entry for museums marked here with an asterisk (*).

- 1 **Pejo 1914–1918. La guerra sulla porta**
A collection of relics recovered in the mountains of the Ortles-Cevedale group and everyday objects used by the Italian and Austro-Hungarian soldiers.



- 2 **Museo della Guerra di Vermiglio**
In a new display, the museum houses the collection of Emilio Serra's relics, tireless retriever of First World War artefacts. During the summer it organizes guided tours to the forts of the Tonale barrage.



- 3 **Forte Strino**
The first of the forts built in the higher part of the Vermiglio Valley hosts an exhibition dedicated to the "White War" and exhibitions of contemporary art. During the summer it organises guided tours to the forts of the Tonale barrage.



- 4 **Museo della Guerra Bianca Adamellina "Recuperanti in Val Rendena"**
A remarkable collection of relics from the Adamello-Carè Alto front recovered by the "Cultural History Association of the 1915-18 Adamello White War" in Spiazzo Rendena.



- 5 **Museo della Grande Guerra in Valle del Chiese – Bersone**
Exhibits a rich collection of wartime equipment, uniforms and artefacts from the glaciers of Adamello. It also houses significant reconstructions of the Austrian and Italian high mountain buildings.



- 6 **Museo Garibaldino – Bezzeca**
Relics of the Third War of Independence (from here Garibaldi sent his "Obbedisco") and the First World War and evidences of the exodus of the population in Bohemia. Nearby, the historic park of Colle di Santo Stefano, the military ossuary church and Italian trenches.



- 7 **Museo di Riva del Garda**
Located in the Rocca, in the history section named "Il lago, gli uomini, i tempi" exhibits documents and relics of the military events of the First World War in the zone of Riva del Garda.



- 8 **Museo Storico Italiano della Guerra Rovereto**
One of the most important Italian Museums of the First World War, with archive and library, has a large Artillery section and important collections of blades and firearms, both ancient and modern.



- 9 **Museo Forte Belvedere-Gschwent Lavarone**
Among the best preserved forts of the First World War, it houses a modern museum with exhibits and multimedia installations. It illustrates the history of the fort, its garrison and the military events that have affected the plateau.



- 10 **Centro Documentazione Luserna**
A wide hall illustrates the fighting that has affected the Folgaria, Lavarone and Luserna plateau territory and the system of fortresses between Folgaria and Asiago. During the summer months it organises guided tours to nearby Fort Luserna.



- 11 **Mostra permanente della Grande Guerra in Valsugana e sul Lagorai – Borgo Valsugana**
An interesting exhibition on the war between the Seven Municipalities plateau, Valsugana and the Lagorai-Cima d'Asta chain, curated by the "Cultural History Association of Eastern Valsugana and Tesino".



- 12 **Mostra permanente della Grande Guerra sul Lagorai – Caoria**
The museum holds memories of the war fought in the mountains of Lagorai, the tragedy of evacuated civilian population and of the men serving in the Austro-Hungarian Army.



- 13 **Collezione di cimeli del Rifugio Cauriol**
A strategic starting point for excursions to the mountains of Cauriol, Cardinal and Busa Alta, theatres of bitter fighting in 1916. It exhibits a collection of war memorabilia collected in Val Sàdole and Ziano by Aldo Zorzi.



- 14 **"Sul fronte dei ricordi" – Moena**
The association "On the Front of Memories" curates an exhibition of memorabilia at Someda (Moena), develops the Costabella-Cima-Bocche front also with the photographic exhibition "War to the War".



- 15 **Museo della Grande Guerra 1914-18 Passo Fedaia**
A remarkable collection of war relics in perfect condition, originating mostly from the Marmolada front, following the withdrawal of the glacier.



- 16 **Museo Nazionale Storico degli Alpini Trento**
Located on the rock overlooking the city of Trento, this museum exhibits relics, weapons and photographs on the history of the Alpine Corps, with particular attention to the two World Wars.



- 17 **Fondazione Museo storico del Trentino Trento**
Centre for exhibitions and study and a reference point for the history of local communities, this site promotes the history of the city of Trento, Trentino and the area corresponding to historic Tyrol.



- 18 **Museo dell'Aeronautica Gianni Caproni Trento**
Local Department of Museo Tridentino di Scienze Naturali, exhibits numerous original historic aeroplanes are exhibited, some of which are unique in the world, as well as documents, relics and works of art regarding the history of flight.



- 19 **Museo della Società Alpinisti Tridentini Trento**
Here the history of SAT (Società degli Alpinisti Tridentini) and alpinism in Trentino is traced. Records on the history of irredentism and the First World War in the mountains are also maintained. The History Group organises conferences and educational excursions.
